

# UKTI Nuclear Outward Mission to China

19-25 May, 2013



UK Trade & Investment (UKTI) at the British Embassy in Beijing is happy to announce its 2013 UKTI Nuclear Outward Mission.

The mission will provide delegates the opportunity to be part of the UK pavilion at the 10th China International Exhibition on Nuclear Power Industry (<http://www.coastal.com.hk/nuclear/>), an annual industry show, from May 23-25, to be held in Shanghai.

As well as participating at the exhibition, we hope to be able to take missioners to visit both Beijing and Guangdong, to take part in a series of meetings, networking events and site visits with major Chinese nuclear companies and their subsidiaries. A **tentative** program is as follows:

## Tentative program

### Sun 19 May

Delegates arrive in Beijing; briefing on China market and mission programme

### Mon 20 May

Delegates attend meetings/seminars in Beijing (with e.g. CNNC and their subsidiaries) and then travel to Shenzhen in Guangdong Province

### Tue 21 – Wed 22 May

Delegates attend meetings/seminars in Shenzhen (with e.g. CGNPC and their subsidiaries) and carry out a site visit to a local nuclear project

### Thu 23 – Sat 25 May

Delegates join the UK pavilion at the China International Exhibition on Nuclear Power Industry

China is the world's fastest growing nuclear market in all aspects in the civil nuclear industry, including new build, waste management and decommissioning, and nuclear fuel cycle. UK manufacturers, engineering firms and specialist companies, such as consultancies and law firms, are encouraged to participate in the mission to explore commercial opportunities and seek potential partners in the market.



UK delegates who join the mission will be charged a fee under UKTI's Overseas Market Introduction Services program.

The cost will range from £816 (ex VAT) for only taking part in the UK pavilion at the show (compared to the official rate - \$480 per sqm. for a minimum 3x3 metre stand), to £1428 (ex VAT) for attending the whole one-week program.

Please note these costs are only indicative at the moment. Please also be aware that financial support may be available for some companies to attend this mission.
